

## South Dakota Early Childhood Enrichment Orientation to Child Care

In an effort to assist you in meeting your orientation training requirements, we have created a list of Early Childhood Connections trainings that meet the various training area requirements. You can use previous trainings as far back as January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015. All future ECC classes that meet an orientation training area will have the training area listed in the class description. ### Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases:

<b>Communicable Disease Jeopardy</b> (Offered 11/03/15)	This class will cover many aspects related to communicable diseases as well as the facts about flu shots. Pathways: #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases.
<b>Immunizations</b> (Offered 08/03/15)	This class will discuss why immunizations are important for the health of the children and the health of the employees. The various diseases that are prevented by vaccines will be discussed. How to determine if a child's immunization record shows that the child meets the state regulations for immunizations will be covered as well. Pathways: #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases
<b>Infectious Diseases</b> (Offered 02/15/16)	Participants will look at many different infectious diseases, how to prevent the spread of diseases. Pathways #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases
<b>Respiratory Illnesses</b> (Offered 02/01/16 & 10/05/15)	Participants will look at different respiratory illnesses they may encounter. Pathways: #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases
<b>Respiratory Illnesses/Infection Control</b> (Offered 02/02/15)	Participants will look at different respiratory illnesses and other types of infections they may encounter. Pathways: #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases
<b>Itchy Red Bumps</b> (Offered 12/07/15)	Is it Chicken Pox or Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease? This training reviews safety standards for early childhood programs. Learn about common childhood illnesses, communicable illnesses, identification and prevention. Pathways: #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases

### Safe Sleep Practices and Reducing the Risk of SIDS:

<b>Child Abuse and Neglect</b> (Offered 03/03/15, 05/04/15, 06/08/15, 12/21/15, 03/28/16, 04/04/16 & 04/18/16)	This class covers how to recognize potential abuse, procedures for reporting child abuse or neglect, and how to support an abused child. Pathways #2: Child Abuse and Neglect
<b>Good Night, Sleep Tight</b> (Offered 07/06/15 & 05/02/16)	Learn the newest recommendations to decrease the risk of SIDS. Pathways #6: Program Safety

### Administration of Medications in Child Care:

<b>Medication Administration</b> (Offered 03/02/15 & 03/07/16)	What is the best way to administer medications in a childcare setting? This session will give you some ideas on ways to ensure medications are given safely. We will also review South Dakota rules and regulations for medication administration. Pathways #5: Identification and Prevention of Communicable Diseases
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## Providing a Safe Environment in Child Care:

<b>Playground Safety, Supervision and Participation</b> (Offered 04/07/15 & 08/12/15)	Participants will review safety issues and maintenance of the playground areas. We will also discuss adequate and appropriate supervision of children while on the playground, and look at ideas for participating with the children to develop physical and social skills. Pathways #6: Program Safety
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## Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma:

<b>Child Abuse and Neglect</b> (Offered 03/03/15, 05/04/15, 06/08/15, 12/21/15, 03/28/16, 04/04/16 & 04/18/16)	This class covers how to recognize potential abuse, procedures for reporting child abuse or neglect, and how to support an abused child. Pathways #2: Child Abuse and Neglect
<b>The Period of Purple Crying</b> (Offered 03/12/15 & 2/25/16)	Healthy babies can cry a lot in their first 5 months of life. This program is a new way to understand this crying. It explains what is normal, what you can expect, and how to keep the baby safe. It is based on over 25 years of research on infant crying by leading child development and medical experts. Participants will also review information regarding Shaken Baby Syndrome as well. Pathways #2: Child Abuse and Neglect

## Emergency Preparedness and Planning for Child Care Programs:

<b>Emergency Preparedness: Prepare Because You Care</b> (Offered 05/18/15)	Disaster can strike quickly and without warning. What would you do if you were forced to evacuate or were confined to your building? Pathways #6: Program Safety
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## Basic First Aid for Child Care Providers:

<b>First Aid in an Early Childcare Setting</b> (Offered 02/12/15, 02/16/15, 02/25/15, 04/22/15, 04/30/15, 06/22/15, 07/22/15, 08/19/15, 09/01/15, 09/14/15, 11/04/15, 12/14/15, 01/27/16, 02/11/16, 02/15/16, 04/19/16, 05/18/16, 05/31/16)	Participants will gain knowledge related to common childhood accidents and injuries in addition to receiving instruction that will enable them to perform First Aid. Pathways: Basic First Aid
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
